Throughout our journey, we have implemented various impactful programmes.

Our economic empowerment program has successfully trained over 2,000 vulnerable women and airls through a one-month business course, providing them with essential skills to thrive. Our microfinance initiatives have created opportunities for more than 5,000 women and girls to access financing in the form of small startup loans, seed grants, and village banking, empowering them to build sustainable livelihoods.

Through our Women's Rights and Gender Equality Program, we have safeguarded over 2,500 women and girls from gender-based abuse. We have conducted awareness campaigns, pursued legal action, provided alternative solutions, and fostered safe and dignified spaces for women and girls to thrive with diginity and without fear.

Our Family Strengthening Programme is designed to address both the immediate needs and long-term aspirations of families in our communities. Through this program, we empowered families to engage in vegetable aardenina, fostering food security and self-sufficiency. Our Share a Meal initiative provided food to families in need, combating hunger and malnutrition. Additionally, the Give a Goat initiative offered a sustainable source of livelihood, while we also education for supported needy children, ensuring that the next generation has the opportunity to thrive.

The health and nutrition

program has significantly enhanced the well-being of over 3,000 women and families by providing better medical care, timely diagnoses, and improved nutrition, resulting in transformative changes in their lives.

As we look to the future, we are focused on establishing the Women's Life Centre, a space that will offer women, girls, and families access to skills training, mentorship, medical care, and a safe haven from abuse. This Centre will serve as a preparation hub, helping them to build a brighter and more secure future.

Financial Access for Women

205 vulnerable women accessed finances to start up income generating activities. The inability to access finances is a very big challenge to many

poor women especially those living in the rural communities since financial institutions require collateral which they do not have.

SustainMe has made it possible for the women to access collateral free small startup loans through the women's groups which help in starting up and or boost their small businesses.

During my time at SustainMe, I was immersed in an environment that thrived on creativity and innovation encouraging interns like myself to explore and implement ideas aimed at fostering sustainable development. Under the expert quidance of my mentors, I gained valuable insights into the diverse strategies and approaches required to initiate and sustain impactful projects. From project planning to community engagement and resource mobilization, I honed essential skills that are fundamental to drivina sustainable change.

At SustainMe, the ethos of empowerment was tangible, driving us to think critically and devise solutions that not

only addressed immediate challenges but also fostered long term benefits for the community. SustainMe supported such women at the grassroots with inspiring gifts of goats, mosquito nets, seed grants among others. Access to inspiring gifts for the poor women and families enables them to create Sustainable livelihood which allows them to jump the poverty line.

Health and Nutrition for Women and Families

Our Health and Nutrition Program has been a lifeline for many in the rural communities we serve, especially women and children who cannot afford medical care. Through this program, we have facilitated access to medical services, including diagnosis, treatment, and nutritional support for malnourished children.

Village banking for rural wome

Village banking is a community based microfinance model that aims to empower individuals in rural and marginalized communities to improve their economic situation. Members make regular contributions to a collective saving fund which is managed and administered by the entire community.

Village banks help women to access small loans through self-raised funds, access saving opportunities and emergency funds. These loans serve purposes such as starting or expanding small businesses, Every day, we encounter malnourished children and sick women who, without our intervention, would remain ill for extended periods or, tragically, lose their lives. We are proud to see this program restoring hope and dignity, ensuring that women and children can lead healthier and more fulfilling lives

paying for education or healthcare or meeting other urgent needs. With a total of 4 village banks now, we have managed to serve over 350 women and girls living in rural and marginalized communities.

We were privileged to collaborate with extraordinary volunteers from around the globe. Their expertise and skills were instrumental in amplifying SustainMe's impact, enabling us to achieve even greater success in our mission.

We extend our heartfelt gratitude to these dedicated individuals for their invaluable contributions and sacrifices to uplift women, girls, and families from poverty. Skills for Women and Girls

At SustainMe, our goal is to empower women and girls to create sustainable livelihoods and become employable. To achieve this, we have provided training in a variety of

skills, including business, financial literacy, entrepreneurship, and vocational skills. These programmes lay a solid foundation for Volunteers to build independence and achieve self-sufficiency.

Our business, finance, and entrepreneurship training covered critical areas such as sales and marketing, customer care, record-keeping, business positioning, and money management. Vocational training focused on practical skills like hairdressing, farming, and sewing.

To celebrate their achievements, all participants received certificates and recognition upon completing the training, affirming their readiness to take the next step towards economic empowerment.

Education for children

At the start of the academic year, school children and students returned to their respective schools and colleges. We sponsor a number of children paying for their school fees and providing equipment.

Women engage in vegetable gardening

One of the major problems faced by our local communities is food insecurities. These insecurities ore crucial contributors of

are crucial contributors of malnutrition in communities hence causing nutritional related illnesses. Through our family strengthening



programme, rural women have been economically empowered through vegetable gardening to improve their nutrition as well as earn an extra income. Throughout the season, women planted and harvest their vegetables leading to food security, better nutrition and increase in household incomes

This year, we were honored to give out 10 goats to vulnerable women and families for their remarkable contribution towards transforming their lives and that of their families.
